Hao Zhang is Professor and former Head of Statistics at Purdue University. He is Fellow of American Statistical Association and an Elected Member of the International Statistical Institute. He is serving or has served editorial boards of Journal of the American Statistical Association, Statistica Sinica, Environmetrics, and Statistics & Probability Letters. His research interests are primarily in spatial and spatio-temporal statistics. His work includes both theoretical investigation into asymptotic properties of inferences methods for spatial data and development of algorithms for the analysis of big spatial data. He collaborates extensively with researchers in ecology, environmental sciences, climatology, and natural resources.
